



Art+Object's November 2018 auction of Important Paintings & Contemporary Art was an outstanding success, realising a sale total of over 3.4 million dollars. The sale featured three major paintings by Don Binney from the period of 1965–1970, all of which found appreciative new homes. Perhaps the most remarkable was lot 54, *Pastoral, Te Henga* which achieved a new auction record for the artist of \$684 685.

However it was also a successful evening for contemporary art and artists, as shown on the present pages.

Taken together these results indicate the underlying strength and continued growth of the New Zealand art market across all tiers with renewed strengthening particularly evident at the top end where the best examples by our leading twentieth century artists continue to be increasingly sought-after.



All these posters have been conservationally framed to not only enhance but protect their historic beauty for many years ahead.




